District 5 May 11, 2011 Monthly Meeting

DCM opened the meeting with the Responsibility Statement.

Introductions: 19 people present

Secretary's report: Report accepted after amended that the International Conference made \$850,000 not \$85,000.

Treasurer's report: Beginning savings account was \$452.92 with.09 int. ending with \$453.01. Checking account balance started with \$1531.75, group contributions of \$430.00 (5 groups), disbursements of \$117.34(DCM \$93.35, Admin.\$10.49 and rent \$13.50) ending balance \$1844.41. The treasurer also handed out job descriptions to be put in the binder and the 2011 proposed budget to be taken back to groups for approval.

DCM report: The spring conference in Sturgeon Bay was discussed. The delegate will give his report from the General Service Conference held in New York. That will be given on Sat. morning.

Group & meeting updates: The Alano Club in Menomonie has moved to 544 S. Broadway.

Workshops: none

Old business: Last month it was suggested the District buy Grapevines for the Jails in District 5. It was asked for the GSR's to bring it back to their groups, the District failed to contact the Corrections Chair about this and it was brought to our attention this month how unfair that was to the Corrections Committee. A motion was made to table this until the chair has a chance to talk to her committee.

Treatment chair has stepped down so District is looking to elect a new chair next month. The District CPC and Area 74 CPC chairs are helping with the National Institute for Alcohol and Drug Abuse conference held in Menomonie June 12-16,2011.

Quarterly reports:

Corrections chair asked to be reinbursed **\$10.00 for rent**. The committee has been busy going into jails. BTG had a need for a contact from Ellsworth and Boyceville area. Jerry and Corey W. volunteered to help.

PI: There was 3 people at the last meeting so things are looking up.. The committee went out to the Alma area and handed out meeting lists. They will be in the Menomonie area next so are in need of volunteers.

Webmaster: He has updated meetings lists in Maiden Rock, Menomonie and encourages everyone to make sure that up to date meeting lists are on your literature tables. He also will put flyer's on the web page if sent to him. There is a link to the CVIG on the web as well.

The webmaster has done the job for 10+ years now and would like to step down. Some qualifications are Comp. knowledge, access to a computer and billing knowledge. He would like to have the GSR's take this back to their meetings.
