August 10,2011 District 5 Meeting Minutes

DCM opened the meeting with the Responsibility Statement.

Introductions: 15 people present

Secretary's report: Read and accepted.

Treasurer's report: The beginning savings account balance \$453.09 with .02 int. ending balance of \$453.11. Checking account beginning balance of \$1748.20, (4) groups contributions of \$140.00, disbursements of \$66.08 (CPC \$32.00,Newsletter \$20.58 and rent for August of \$13.50) leaving the ending balance of \$1822.12.

DCM report: Elections will be held in October. Positions opening are DCM, alternate DCM, secretary, treasurer and all committees. The Delegate will be doing a workshop in River Falls, WI on Aug.27 followed by potluck and speaker. Corrections chair asked about having elections for that position at their meeting instead of at District. Paul was checking into that. One of the GSR's suggested the following" District 5 AA committee chairpersons shall be elected by members of their respective committees unless the committee is unable to do so or defers to the October District election meeting." It was decided that the Corrections committee will hold their elections at their Oct. meeting. Paul also, asked to be **reinbursed \$63.72 for** gas to Area Committee meeting. Motion made and accepted.

Groups and meetings update: nothing

Workshop: One of our GSR's was present at the Gay Pride rally held at Carson Park in Eau Claire, WI and had a very good response. All the pamplets he had were taken and it was great turn-

out. He asked to be reinbursed\$**11.92** for registration, stamp and copies. Motion was made and accepted to reinburse him.

New business: It was brought up that perhaps the people who volunteer to make a report on steps, traditions and concepts at our District meeting could send in something to the Districtview to give the newsletter more substance. Cheryl asked **treasurer to be reinbursed \$15.99** for ink for the printer. Motion made and accepted.

Corrections: reported that she had taken the idea of sending Grapevines to the different jails back to her committee and they agree upon it so they bought bundles of 30 for the different facilities (Buffalo, Dunn, Pepin, E.C., Trempelau and Pierce). She asked to be reinbursed \$344.00 for the Grapevines and \$10.00 for rent. Motion made and accepted.

PI: They are continuing to go to the different towns to hand out meeting lists. Menomonie will be the next city. The PI committee meets on the 3rd Wed. quarterly.
