July 11, 2012 District 05 <u>Meeting Minutes</u>

Meeting was opened with the Responsibility Statement.

Introductions: 20 people present of which 10 people were GSR's

Secretary's report: Was approved

Treasurers report: The beginning savings account balance was \$453.31 with .02 int. leaving the ending balance at \$453.33. Checking account beginning balance was \$1480.10 with (1 group) contribution of \$25.00, and disbursements of \$276.38(rent \$13.50,

DCM Expenses \$186.45 and Newsletter expense of \$76.43 creating an ending **balance of \$1228.72.** Qty group contributions were **\$210**. 1st and 2nd qtr total expenses were **\$1118.37** and income was **\$800**. Remaining balances in the budget for each account was supplied and files with minutes. All reports were read and approved.

DCM Report Gary spoke of Paul Sheehan passing and read the article from the Now and then about Stan's passing wth 57 years of soberity. **Group and meeting updates** A current meeting list was provided with the Eau Claire Sunday meeting removed.

Workshop report: No WS scheduled this month and nothing coming up in the district.

Old Business: Discussions were had with all GSR's that talked to their groups about the voting rights at the assemblies. A major of groups felt the past delegates shouldn't have a vote. They can voice their vote as their meetings. There was talk of some delegates not wanting to come any more. Talk of maybe have the delegates do a workshop as the assemblies to share their wisdom.
