January 11, 2012 District 05 <u>Meeting Minutes</u>

Meeting was opened with the Responsibility Statement. Introductions: 22 people present

Secretary's report: Was read and approved.

Treasurers report: Beginning savings account balance was \$453.19 with .02 int. leaving the ending balance at 453.21. Checking account beginning balance was \$1560.59 with (5 groups) contributions of \$225.00, Lit sales \$15 & Disbursements of \$78.50 which were rent (Jan) \$13.50, CPC rent \$10, janitor X-mas gift \$25 & DCM Expenses \$30 leaving an ending balance in checking of \$1722.09. Jaynee presented the 2011 committee expenses. Will be reviewed at next Meeting on Feb 8th. Jaynee can present itemized expenses if necessary also. 2011 Annual group contributions was provided by group. Great presentation Jaynee. Reports were accepted.

DCM Report: Gary attended the area committee meeting 12/17. Gary read the DCM job description and welcomed all new GSR's and

committee members. Gary will try and get a copy of motions with details for the Feb. meeting Alt Delegate so we can take to the Groups. Gary also discussed proposed order of business for Area 74 spring assembly which is March 24th & 25th in 3 lakes.

Group and meeting updates: Asking all new GSR's to get registered with GSO and the area.
