April 11, 2012 District 05 Meeting Minutes

Meeting was opened with the Responsibility Statement.

Introductions: 25 people were present

Secretary's report: Read in meeting and was approved

Treasurers report:Beginning savings account balance was \$453.25 with .02 int. leaving ending balance of \$453.27. Checking account beginning balance was \$1753.09 with 2 group contributions of \$215 & disbursement of \$134.85. This included \$10 rent for corrections, PO Box Rent \$46 for corrections. Newsletter printing costs of \$65.35 and Districts April rent of \$13.50 leaving a balance of \$1815.24. Need a hard copy of report yet. Read by Jayme and approved.

DCM Report: Gary attended the Delegates workshop and area assembly. Thanked all those that came. Gary asked those that attended the delegates work shop to give a brief report on what the committee's discussed. Treatment committee report given by Jason and 2 others commented. Grapevine report was given by Anita. Andy gave the PI committee report. Corrections committee report was provided by Terri. DCM discussed other committee's items. April 14th of 2012 is the dead line for having your group register with the GSO to be able to vote on items that are coming up. It costs \$5800 to seat our delegate and Gary was asked to provide information on the break out of how that money is used. A Reminder to get your flyers for upcoming events out to the newsletter and on the District Web site. That is a great way to get the word out if you want them well attended. DCM asked to be reimbursed \$171.95 for attending the Delegates work shop and assembly. Motion was made and seconded and then approved.

Group and meeting updates: DCM provided a new meeting lists at the meeting tonight.

Workshop report: Sponsorship work shop April 21st at Mystic Rose Gardens in Baldwin hosted by the Tuesday and Thursday night River Falls AA meetings. Cheryl said the panel is set all but for 1 speaker. Archives, and Inter-group will have items there and a call has been made to the Grapevine to come also.

Old Business: Pete said a location for the Big Book workshop in 2013 hasn't been decided yet. Anita, from the Pacific Group, asked to talk about the district paying for the inter-group phone list in the area. Some concerns that it was a tradition violation of not being self-supporting. Discussions were held. Cheryl stated the inter-group pays for the listing in the local area and is self-supporting. PI committee paid for the listing in the whole district to get the message out the still suffering alcoholic. Consensus was it's not a violation of the traditions.

New Business: Motion was made to not read the secretary's minutes at the beginning of every meeting. The reason is they are now published in the newsletter that everyone gets and they can be reviewed there. We will continue to ask for approval and changes at the start of the meeting. Motion was seconded and approved. (Yea) Also – discuss with your groups to see if they would be willing to donate some Big Books to the CPC committee if they were needed. Jayme received a letter in the PO box from LE Phillips that they are going smoke free May 1*. They don't want it on the grounds or for speakers to coming in smelling like smoke.

Quarterly reports:

Treatment: Craig was not present. DCM will try and contact

CPC: Report provided. Mike requested rent reimbursement for Feb and April rent to Club 12 totaling \$20. Also requested payment for \$95.79 which included 8 Big Books at a cost of \$8 each (\$64) and \$31.79 in mailing costs. Reimbursement was approved by the district. Mike contacted libraries and schools in the district and that is where the books were sent out to. 14 books were sent out or delivered total. There will be follow up to see if they are being used and if more should go out. We can talk to our groups about possibly donating some BB. Dick P. put an AA rack up at LE Phillips to be there during meetings. Mike has been asked to do a 50 minute presentation at UWEC on May 10th. It's part of the Awareness committee at the university. First half will be about what AA is and isn't and the 2nd half will be answering questions. Wynn offered to help with the power point presentation and commented that it might be able to be used at other University's in the district. DCM also offered to help in anyway. Mike will have a report at the next district meeting. **Archives:** Report provided. The committee will be in Eleva and at the upcoming Sponsorship work shop April 21st. Al has done a great job getting the archives out to our area.
