CORRECTIONS REPORT: Molly

The committee requests rent for the monthly meetings (\$30 for \$10/month) to club 12, Steve Heath for \$100 for reimbursement of pamphlets for the district jails (the pamphlets are called "sure beats sitting in a cell"). Reimbursements needed for the corrections party on Saturday November 15th include: Pete Wagner \$52.39 for buns, soda, cups, napkins, and coffee supplies. Please provide clarification about whether or not the rent to the Menomonie club for that event was paid, as requested.

-The Chippewa Prison has requested that regular AA members bring in AA meetings to the prison on a weekly basis. Corrections committee members have taken on the task of fact finding, and decision making re: meeting format, etc. Please contact me if you are interested in being a volunteer for the Chippewa Prison. (Chippewa is outside District 05, but the committee decided to continue serving the area, because there is a need that is not otherwise being filled).

-There is confusion about which committees have decided to take over drug court. My understanding from the joint meeting with corrections, treatment, CPC, and PI, was that corrections was taking on the drug court issues. However, other committees are actively working on this as well. Please clarify.

- Molly Requested, and all was APPROVED!
- \$30.00 for rent, \$52.39 to Pete W. for supplies
- \$100.00 to Steve H. for supplies, \$25.00 for Menomonie leisure center

Since our last report, the committee held regular bi-monthly meetings Nov. 12th and Jan. 21st at the River Falls Alano Club, each with 6 members in attendance.

Volunteers are now in place for the Pierce County Drug Court support effort. At least 3 River Falls AA members currently are sponsoring individuals who are clients of the program.

Currently, we are updating our database of all Hotels/Motels in District 05. The most current meeting lists and contact information will be sent to all. In 2015, we will reach out again to all Places of Worship in the District to provide updated information.

Our project to establish ongoing contacts with School Guidance Counselors continues. There are many schools we have yet to visit, due to a shortage of local volunteers. We have an invitation from the Plum City school district to address an assembly of middle school and high school students. This event, as yet unscheduled, is expected to take place in March or April.

Our second workshop on Anonymity was held Jan. 31st at the Alano Club in Menomonie, with approximately 35 people in attendance. We were very pleased with the wide-ranging and in-depth discussion among the panelists and those in the audience, as this was our stated goal in organizing the workshop. It is our intention that Anonymity workshops should be an annual event across District 05. A third Anonymity workshop has been scheduled for March 14th, 2015 in Eau Claire. A flyer has been prepared and submitted for disbursement. Panelists have been identified, and planning is nearly complete.

Our committee has begun an effort to provide AA information to Senior Citizens in District 05. I have had discussions with the respective directors of the Aging & Disability Resource Centers in Pierce and St. Croix counties to seek their input on how we may best reach out to seniors, especially those living in senior housing facilities. I will submit an informational article to be printed in their newsletters, reaching approximately 2,000 seniors. I have an invitation to speak

at a St. Croix ADRC staff meeting. We soon will reach out to ADRC directors in the other counties in the District. We will provide meeting lists for both AA and Al-Anon, as well as contact information and AA pamphlets, to every senior housing facility in District 05. We hope to provide the same information, and a copy of the Big Book, if possible, to senior centers in each town. We request that the District's supply of books be made available to this purpose.

Our next bi-monthly PI Committee Meeting will be held Wednesday, Mar. 18th at 6:30pm at the Alano Club in River Falls. All AA members who wish to do service to AA are welcome to attend.
