- The committee held its first regular meeting of 2017 on Wednesday, January 18th with 7 members in attendance. We reviewed committee activities for 2016, and discussed our goals for 2017.
- We will do two major mailing projects this year. One will provide updated meeting lists and contact information to every hotel and motel in the District. The other will provide the same information to every place of worship in the district. Work to update both databases has begun. We will hold off on these mailings until the rebuilding of the district's meeting list has been accomplished.
- Work will also continue on both the Schools project and the Senior Citizens project.
- Finally, we assembled 35 information packets for another round of AA presentations at Programs for Change, an outpatient treatment program in Hudson, WI.
- Our next regular meeting will be held Wednesday, March 15th at the River Falls Alano Club. The meeting starts at 6:30PM. All members who wish to do service for AA are welcome to attend.

- During our last meeting we went through the coordinator binders to make sure everyone was on the same page in regards to what each one contained.
- I will be ordering more pamphlets and giving those to coordinators in the very near future.
- Ashley B. stepped down as Fahrman Center coordinator so we have an open spot to fill for that.
- Coordinators must have one year of sobriety and be actively involved in the AA program.
- We are in the process of sending speakers into Affinity House again.

- The list of speakers going into facilities continues to slowly grow.
- Requesting \$120 to pay annual rent (no need to vote as annual budget hasn't been met yet)

- The programs coordinator for the Dunn County Jail requested an additional women's meeting be held in the Dunn County facility if we had available volunteers. As of this time we will be taking in one meeting a month. Normally the first Wednesday of the month, but at times on weekends, depending on volunteer schedules.
- Three new male volunteers have been approved by the county for taking AA meetings into the EC County Jail. The orientation is February 8, 2017, so they will be added to the jail meeting schedule very soon.
- We distributed all Big Books purchased last year, so another order will be placed this month. Bill will be presented at the next meeting.
- We continue to have meetings in county jails and support meetings in the Stanley and Chippewa Falls prisons.
- A reminder that anyone interested in being of service to incarcerated alcoholics is welcome to attend meetings of the District 05 Corrections Committee. Meetings are held at 7:45 pm the first Wednesday of each month in the small building of Club 12 in Eau Claire.
