## Member Share - Step 1 - Ben G

Step 2 of Alcoholics Anonymous (AA) states, "Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity."

I grew up going to church with my mom (mostly) and had a belief in God, although I didn't really have faith that he was interested in working in my life. I believed he was out there, guiding the universe, helping people who really needed it and leading really spiritual people to helping those people.

The words in step two, "restore us to sanity" seemed odd to me too – as if it didn't apply to me since I didn't think I was insane. Insane to me meant a padded room and a straight-jacket. I considered myself a fairly smart, hard-working, productive person with good common sense and a decent moral compass. I certainly wasn't insane - at last not the way I thought of insanity.

But if I was honest with myself and my actions – regarding alcohol, or just life in general – I would have to admit I repeated a lot of the same behaviors, used the same "tools", and tried the same things, over and over again, but always expecting it would be different this time. I tried to get a handle on my drinking by trying different things but the result was the same. I tried to manage and control the people, places, and things in my life, but it always turned out the same.

For me, I had to come to believe that the God I thought was out there would truly work in my life and do things for me that I couldn't seem to do for myself. As a result of coming to this belief, I learned a bit about humility – letting someone else drive the bus of my life. Admitting I don't know all the answers and that my way might not work the way I think it will. This was the beginning of trying something different.

I practiced this through prayer, acknowledging that God was in control and I believed he could restore me to sanity. The more I prayed like this, the stronger this belief was. I started to have confidence and hope.

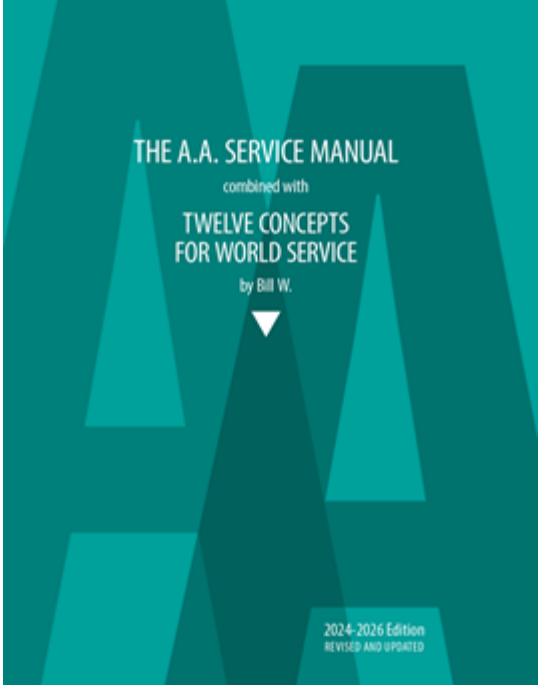

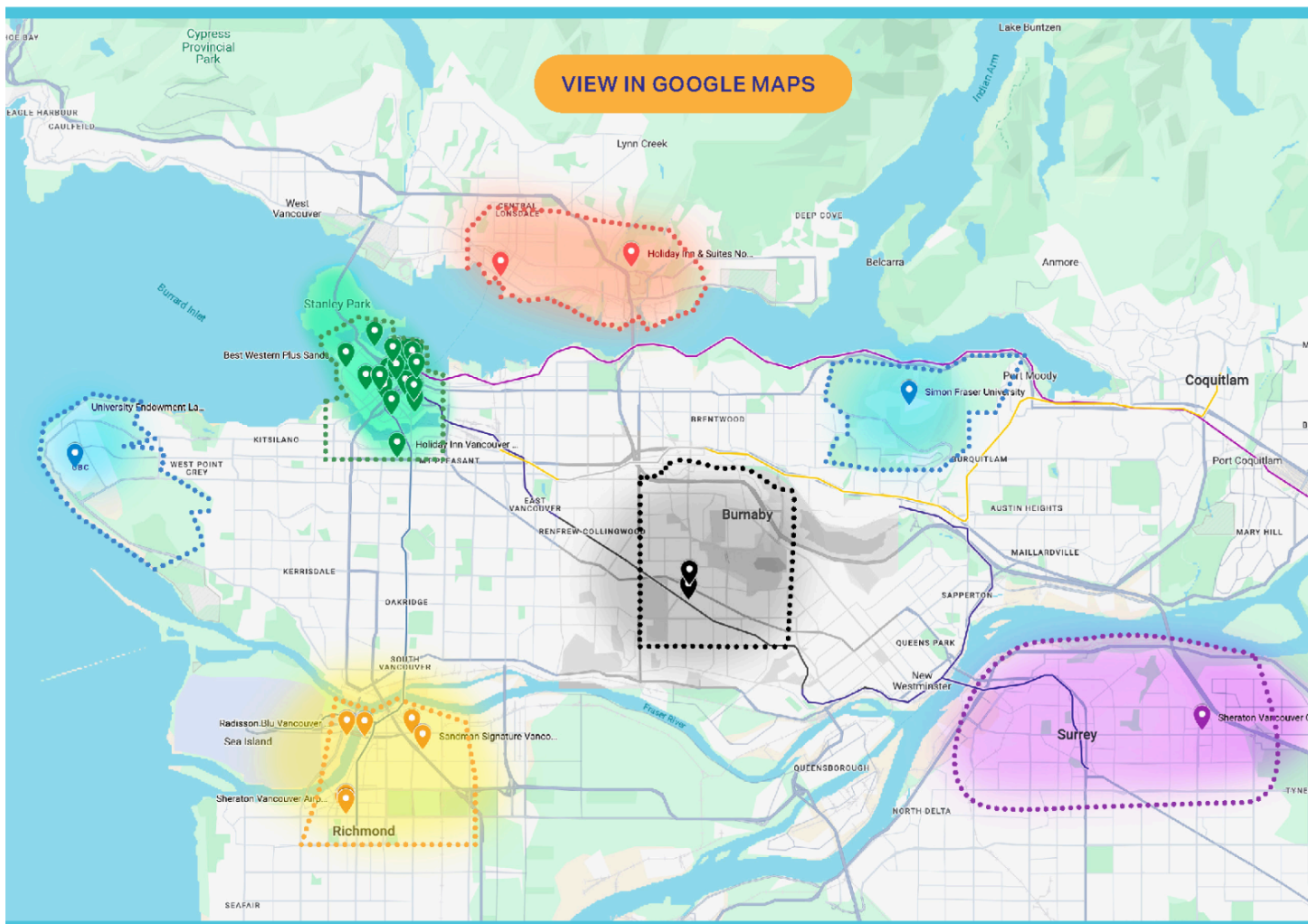

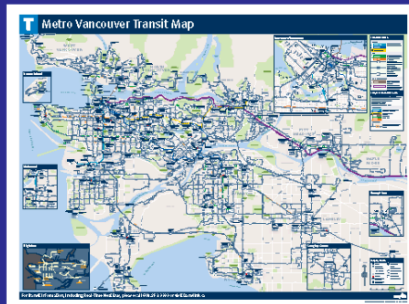
