Discussions:

Max: I wanted to give Weaver the opportunity to talk about new technology.

Weaver: Big picture is moving our email, etc. to one of the bigger email hosts to make it easier for the 2 year position rotation for anybody who wants to take it over. That is why the increase. **Max**: There a way to have zero downtime? (for transitioning)

Weaver: We should be pretty close to no downtime.

Brian: We just paid for some services...will it be prorated back?

Weaver: No. There's a stagger in the charges. It's a corporate way of making more money.

Max: Regarding history, I don't know what kind of email backups we get, but will we be able to maintain all of that?

Weaver: My plan is to move everything. I think that should be possible, but I haven't figured it all out yet. I will start in January if the proposal passes. I will talk about them to everyone first before I pull any triggers. My plan is to keep it all though.

Jim: We should have more flexibility for the workshop spending, that is why there was so much left.

Pat: It was discussed that it was strictly for district committee related things.

Patti: This is from the Northside trying to put on a workshop but not being able to pay the rent. The budget is an incentive for the district to put on workshops. It was for everyone and not just committee members.

Weaver: It is a separate issue that needs to be addressed another time and not be the focus of this meeting.

Pat: It was based on a \$200 per month per potluck.

- Service Workshop Venue (Isaiah)
 - Idea is to put on a nice event and do a lot of outreach to districts and have chairs and members to be more interested and knowledgeable in their positions.
 - Budget proposal is for \$2000
 - Having it at a hotel looks more attractive. We would like to host it at the Best Western in Eau Claire (\$1200 for venues)
 - Having a working lunch type style would be a good thing instead of having people leaving to go get food (\$600 for lunch catering)
 - Any extra expenses and coffee (\$200)

Isaiah: March 29th, 2025 **Pat**: We have money for that?

Isaiah: I was hoping the workshop budget would

be okay for it? **Pat**: It is not.

Some discussion and cross talking over where the original purpose of the budget came from **Brian**: I would like to open for discussion on removing some of the restrictions on using the

workshop budget.

Pat: I will add that to new business. Bring it back to your groups and discuss how we want to use the workshop budget. Do we want to take the 200

	per month for potlucks and allocate it for that instead? Max: Is it safe to say the language of the "workshop" budget confused you? Maybe we should rename it from "workshop" to maybe a "potluck" budget. Kaufua: Present a motion so we can vote on it. Pat: Isaiah needs to bring forth a motion for this specific event. Brian: I would like for individual groups to discuss it. Pat: I agree. We will put it on new business for next month
